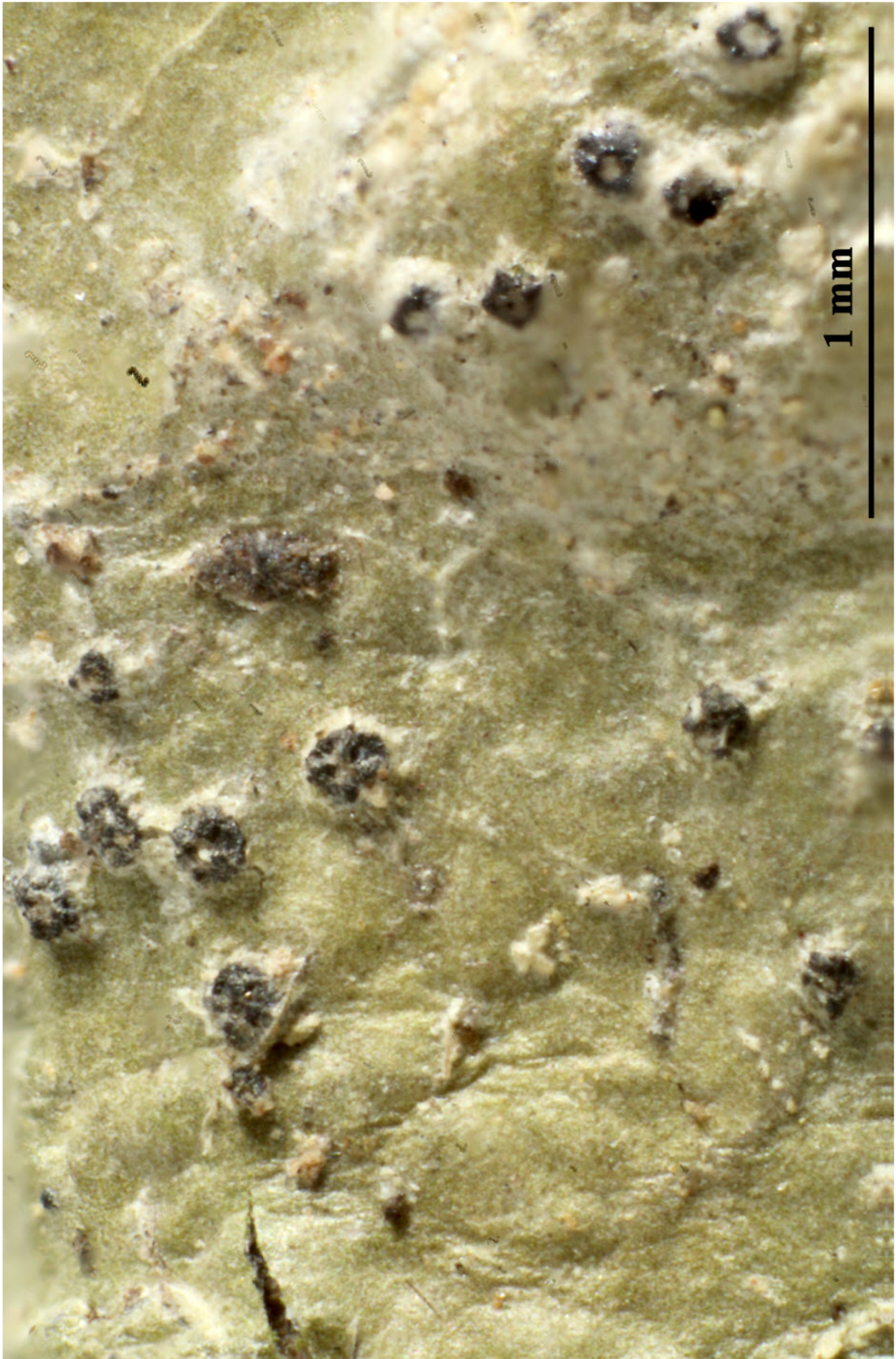

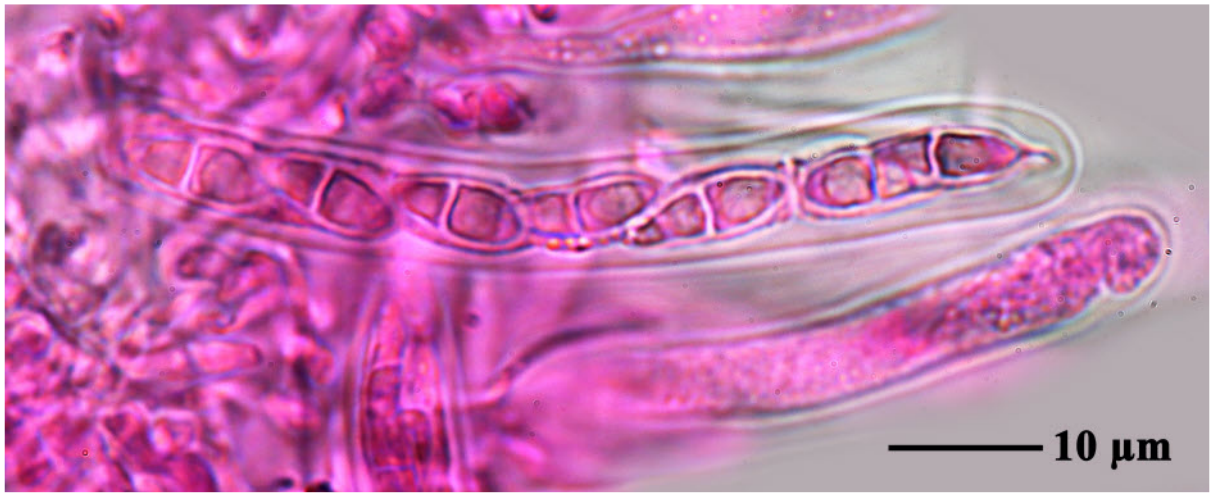
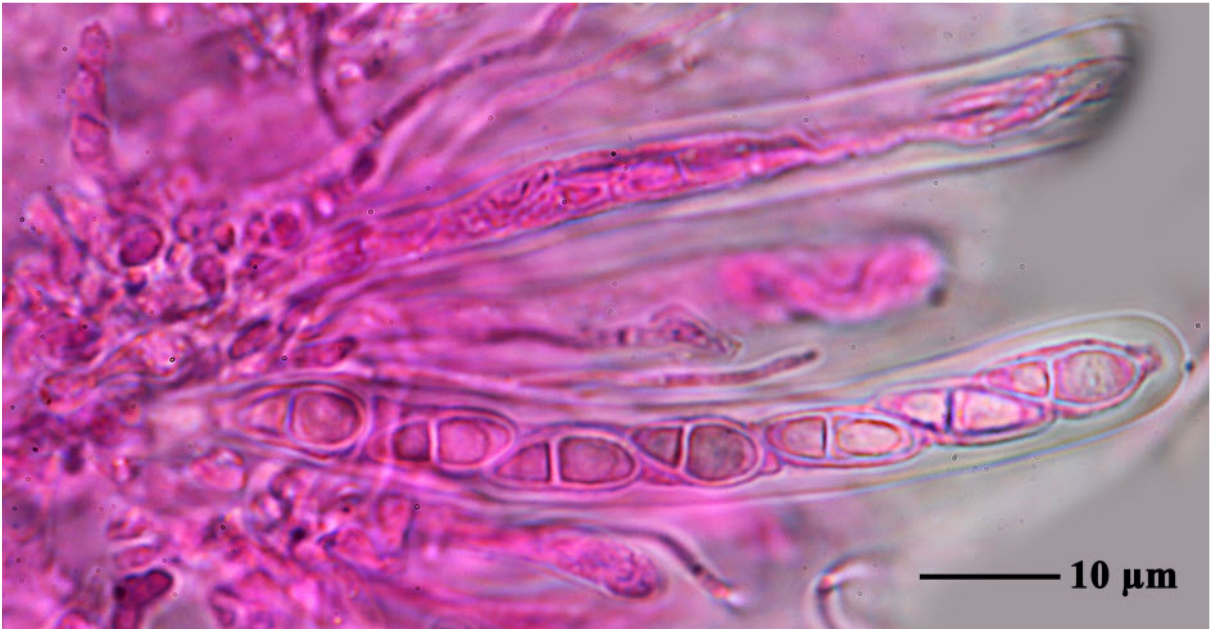
Thallus epiphloeodal, corticate, greenish tan, UV-. Ostiole apical. Ascomata solitary, emergent, flat-topped. Pyrenula like. Ascospores narrowly ovoid, 1-septate, 25-30 x 7.5-10.0 μm , septum submedian, granular ornamented
