

*Everniastrum cirrhatum* (Fr.) Hale ex Sipman

Thallus grey, subcaespitose, dichotomously or subdichotomously lobate. Lobes 0.5-2(-4) mm wide, involute or flat, ciliate. Isidia and Soredia absent. Lower surface black or at the tips pale brown. Chemistry: cortex K<sup>+</sup> yellow, C<sup>-</sup>, KC<sup>-</sup>, P<sup>+</sup> yellow; medulla K<sup>+</sup> yellow>red, C<sup>-</sup>, KC<sup>-</sup>, P<sup>+</sup> yellow>orange; atranorin, salazinic acid (maj), consalazinic acid (min). Central and South America, Asia.
