

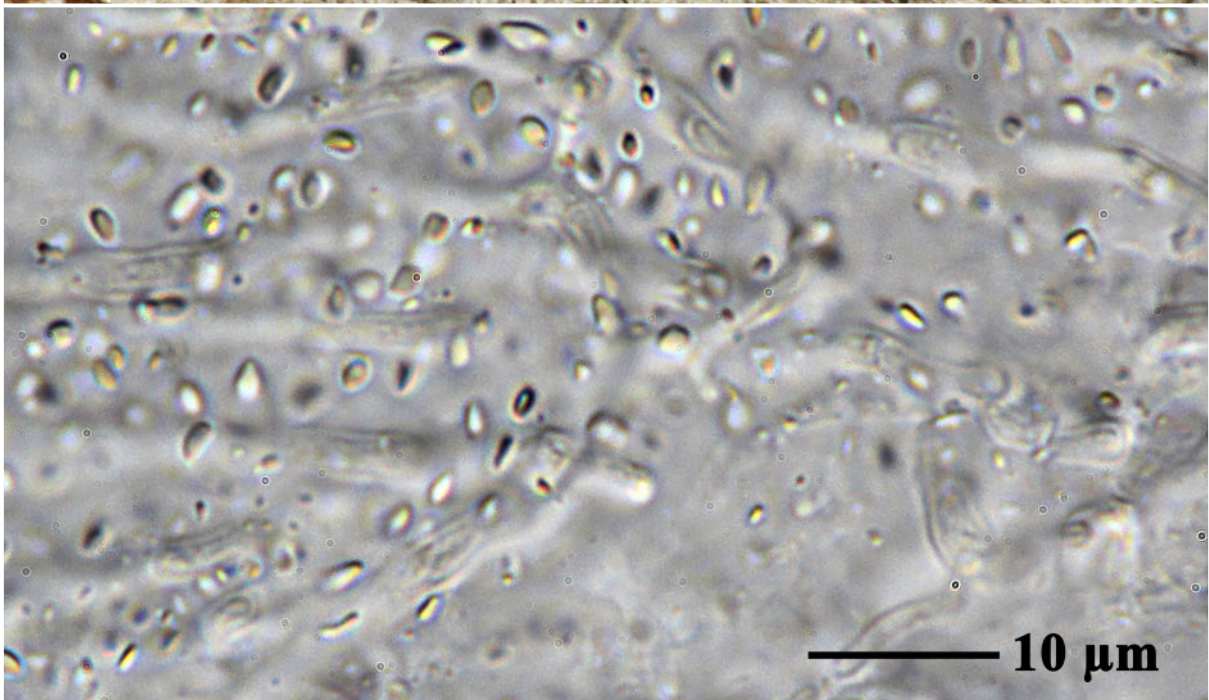
Mycomicrothelia oleosa Aptroot

Biblioth. Lichenol. **44**: 133 (1991); type: Trinidad, Caroni, north bank road, *Britton et al.* 869 (NY—holotype).

Thallus whitish grey, without border lines. *Ascomata* single, with fringe, 0.3–0.5 mm wide and 0.1–0.3 mm tall, wall to 100 μm thick. *Hamathecium* with oil droplets. *Asci* 80–100 \times 12–15 μm . *Ascospores* not constricted, 24–27 \times 8–10.5 μm , with nearly equal locules, with rounded ends, verruculose. *Pycnidia* absent. *Chemistry*. No substances detected. *Distribution*. Neotropical (Brazil, Guyana, Colombia, Trinidad).
