

*Pyrenula mucosa* (Vain.) R.C.Harris

Thallus corticate, brownish to olive-green, with pseudocyphellae. Perithecia single, nearly globose, mostly covered by the thallus, c. 0.3-0.6 mm wide. Wall of perithecium with crystals. Hamathecium not inspersed, J+ orange, filaments not branched. Ascospores 8/ascus, grey-brown, 40-65 x 15-25  $\mu\text{m}$ , muriform, 8-10 segments with c. 3-8 loculi with rounded lumina. Lit.
