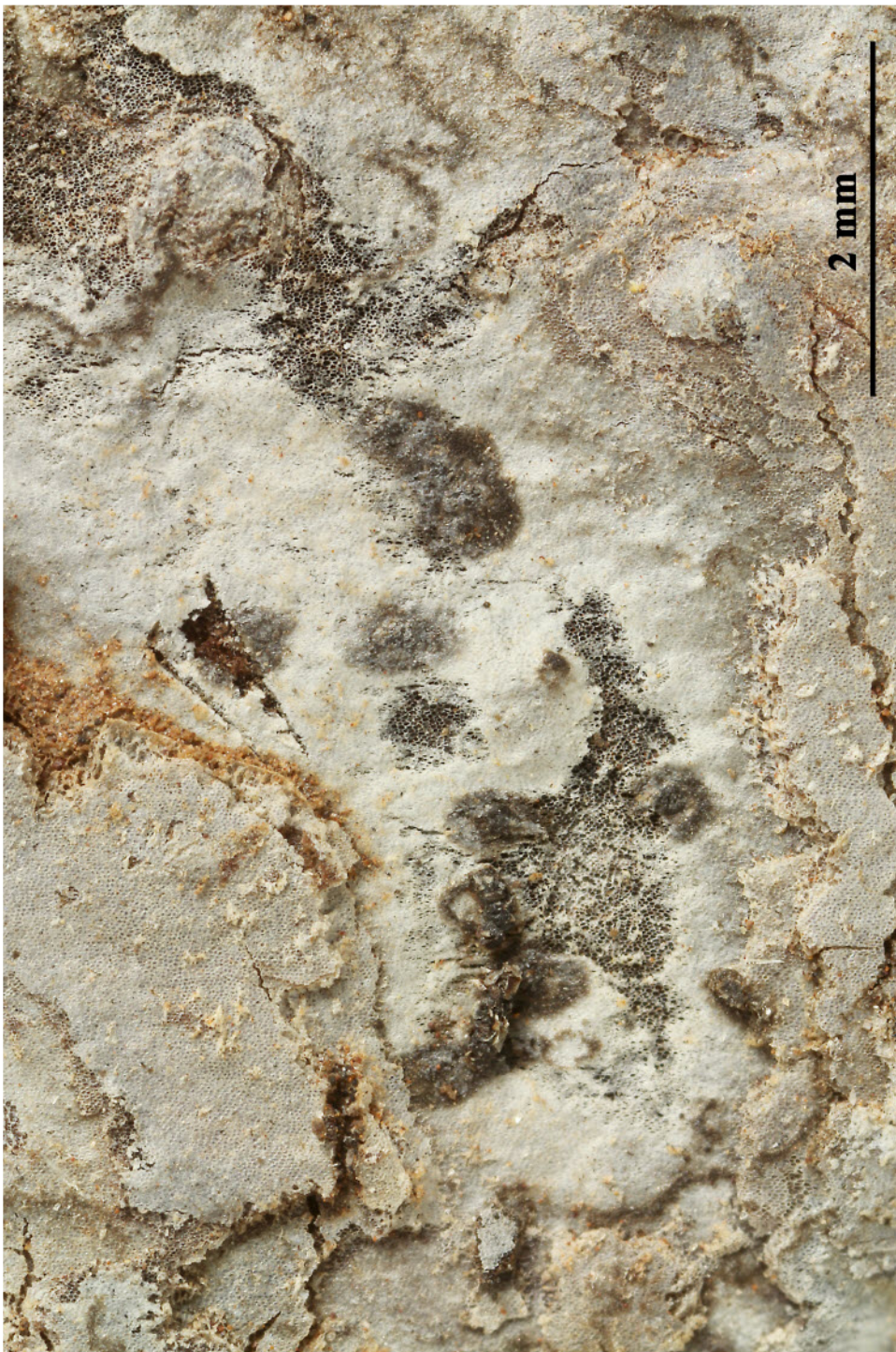


Mycoporium sparsellum Nyl., Ann. Sci. Nat. Bot. ser. 5, 7: 343, (1867)

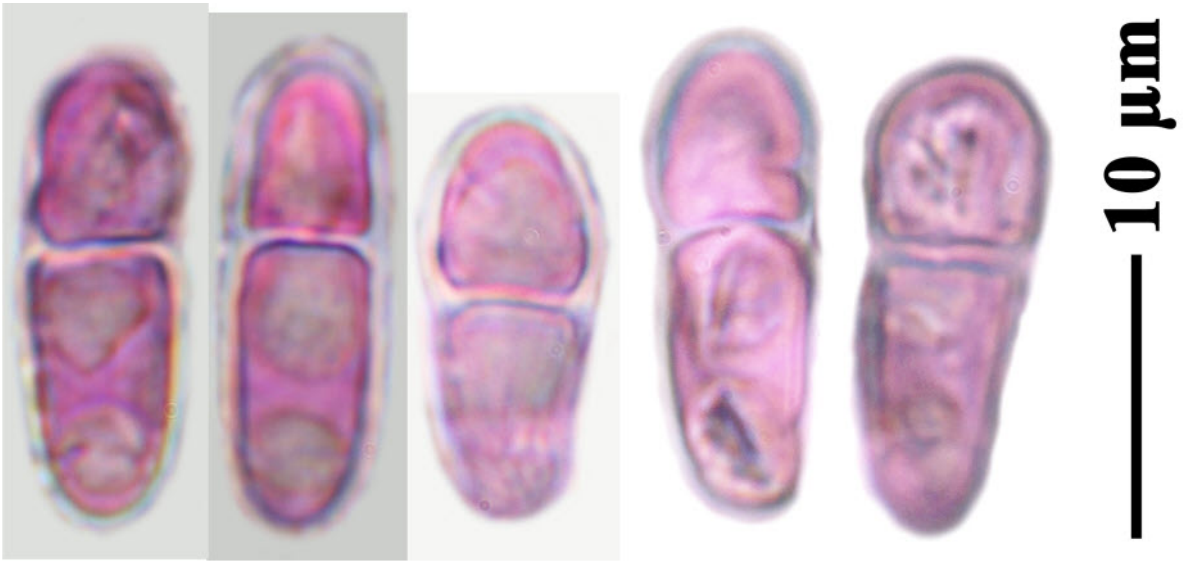
Thallus ecorticate, whitish, UV-. Perithecia solitary, or usually laterally grouped. Ostiole apical. Hamathecium oily, gelatinizing, filaments scarcely visible. Asci pyriform, with long tip. Ascospores 8/ascus, hyaline 1-septate, clavate, 18-22 x 8-10 μm , not ornamented, septum slightly submedian, upper cell somewhat wider than lower cell. Conidiomata absent.
